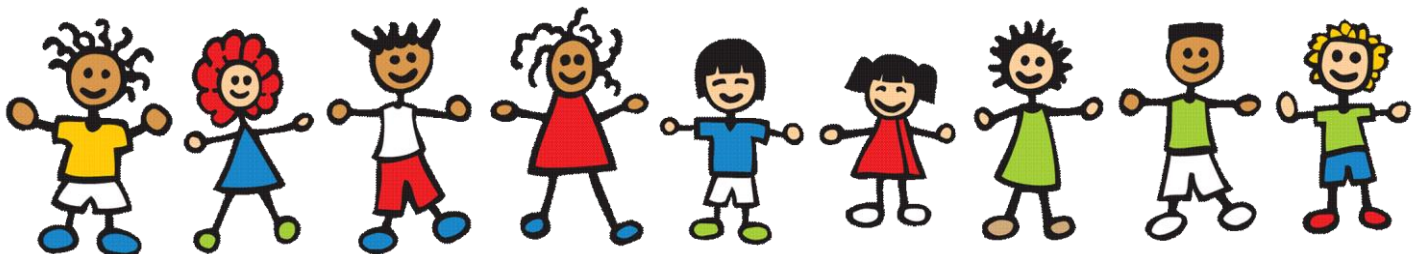

Senior Animator (College and/or University student).	14\$/hr.	4 to 7 weeks. 30 hours.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> College and University students. Positions can range from Kindergarten, elementary or High school groups. You will be responsible for the planning, supervising and leading of a group of children. Completion of the animator training program, retreat attendance and First Aid certification is compulsory.

- All contracts are for 30 paid hours with a 10 hour "volunteer / generosity" clause for a total of 40 hours per week.
- The city law requires all new staff to take part in a first aid training program. We will cover 75% of the fee. Same hours for everyone.
- **Please STAPLE to application, a recent photocopied school transcript (city protocols). Please black out your marks.**
- All new staff (18 years over) will be subject to a police check.
- You must be 16 years old once camp begins to be considered a paid staff (City regulations).
- The YLC's focus is developing positive and visible leaders for our camps, the YLC and the community at large. The camp is "Catholic based" as is the YLC. We will invite, journey and challenge you to explore your spirituality in an open, interactive and nurturing way throughout the animator training, summer and the year. If you are not open to this approach, we ask you respectfully not to apply.
- Camp pay work begins Monday, June 25th and ends on Friday, August 10th for most staff. You are paid every two weeks.
- All staff that is selected to our training meetings is hired on condition of camper registrations and performance at the meetings. By June 7th, we will officially hire our staff. You are not paid for your training time.
